MARIO SAYS, "The planned development of the Churchgate area around St. Mary's Church is loathed, not least by the *Keep Hitchin Special* campaign. A huge amount of public money has been squandered on research in the face of vocal opposition at public meetings I have attended on behalf of Hitchin Green Party. National Heritage has now added its opposition calling it 'an alien' development. The Conservative ruling group who have overseen this disaster refused to meet with National Heritage and listen to the concerns of the people of Hitchin. The Green Party is the only party to have condemned the proposals from the very start. I will continue to voice local opinion at meetings and push for positive alternatives".
